Emily Horrobin née Mason was born in Tittensor in 1885 where her father was a labourer. She is missing on the 1901 census so possibly in service, but by 1911 she was married to Joseph William Horrobin, a woodsman on the Trentham estate at New Park Wood and the couple have two daughters, Ethel and Mary.

The photo appears to have been taken around 1919 when Joseph returned from serving in The Balkans and there was a new baby named Joseph. At the 1919 auction of the Sutherland estate William bought their house for £600. Joseph (Jnr)'s son, Graham and granddaughter, Dawn, both live in Trentham.

Emily Horrobin was not on the 1918 Register of Electors.
